already approved vide letter of even file No. dated 11.6.1992.



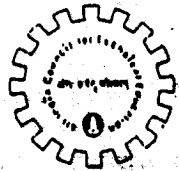

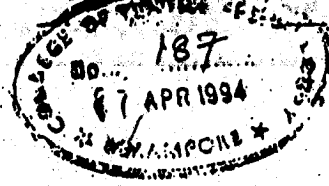

Sub : Approval of the AICTE in respect of College
of Textile Technology, Serampore.

S i r,

You are kindly aware that on promulgation of the AICTE Act - 1987, establishment of an Engineering College or a Polytechnic or introduction of new courses in such institutions require prior approval of the AICTE. The institutions/programmes which have been approved by the AICTE when it was a recommendatory body will be considered as approved by the AICTE (Statutory), in accordance with the decision taken by the present AICTE. The old institutes where the AICTE has conveyed its approval for introduction of any Under-Graduate or Post-Graduate course after its establishment has been treated as AICTE approved institution with the courses and annual intake as on 31.3.94.

The College of Textile Technology, Serampore was established in 1908 as a weaving Institute conducting Certificate Courses. In 1918 the diploma course in Textile Technology was introduced and the name of the Institute was changed in 1939 to Bengal Textile Institute. A 3-year B.Sc. (Tech) degree course in Textile Technology was introduced in the year 1957 and the diploma course was abolished. The name of the Institute was then changed to the College of Textile Technology. With introduction of the 11 year Higher Secondary Education, the duration of the degree course was changed to 4 years. The administrative control of the College was transferred from the Industries Department to the Education Department in 1968. In 1973, the degree course was re-organized by integrating 12 months' Industrial Training with 4-year academic training programme. The Government of India in the letter no. F.3-7/60-T.5 dated 5.8.61 provided additional physical facilities for the College, on the recommendation of the AICTE, to impart instruction at degree level with an annual intake of 30 students. Introduction of Post-Graduate course in Mechanical Processing of Textiles from 1993-94 (not yet started) with an annual intake of 10 has been approved by the AICTE in the letter no. F.39-9/PG/91-AICTE/6216 dated 29.12.92.
